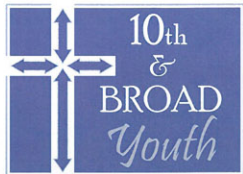
LTC Many of our teens & families are traveling back from LTC today. Keep them in your prayers!

There will be no youth activities tonight due to Easter and LTC. Enjoy the holiday with your family.

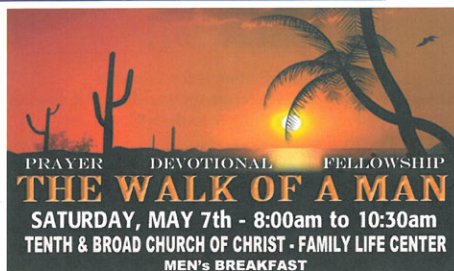

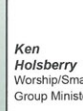
Baby Shower for Paula Parks will be Sunday, May 15th, from 3:30 to 5:30 in the Atrium. She is registered for baby selections at Target.
