Our 4th-6th Grade camp session at Quartz Mountain Christian Camp is scheduled for June 23-28. Find out more on our tnbkids.org website.

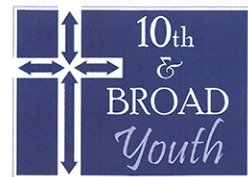
Kids Fest
