Operation KID: Christmas at the Hills

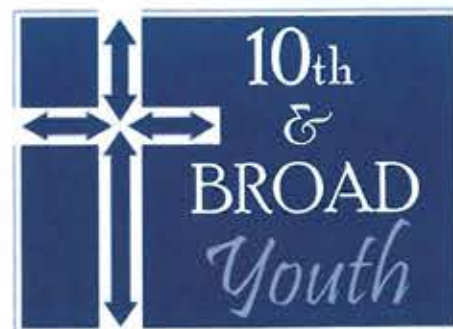
