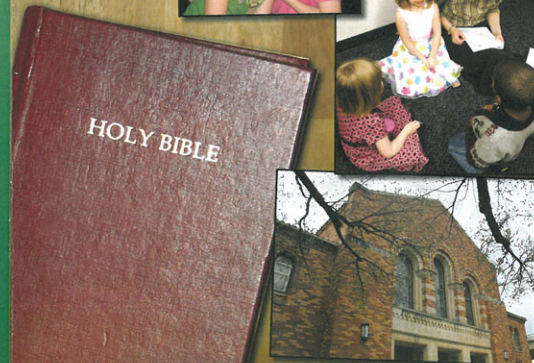

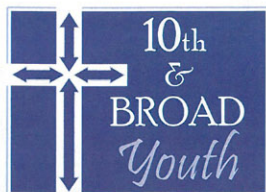

Nursery workers are always needed, so please see Kim Lemons if you are willing to volunteer your time.

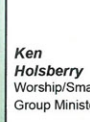
