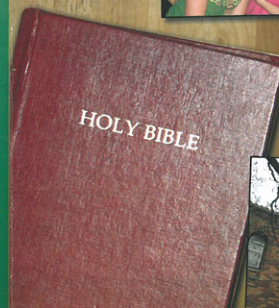
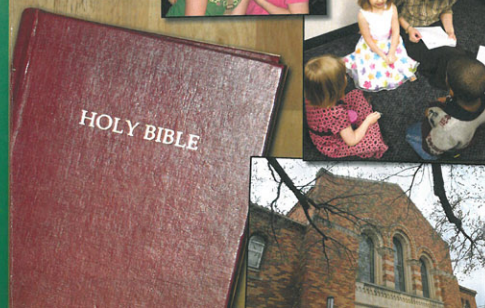

Our 4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade Summer camp dates are June 19-24, 2011. Greg has applications in his office.

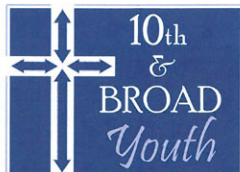

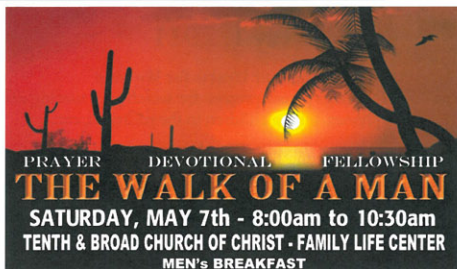
**Senior Sunday** is on May 15<sup>th</sup> this year. Seniors & your families – get your info, pictures & reservations to Allen ASAP!
