Teachers for the Winter Quarter

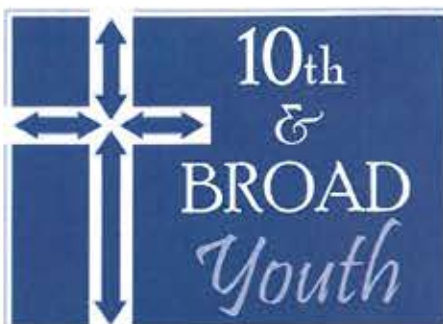
